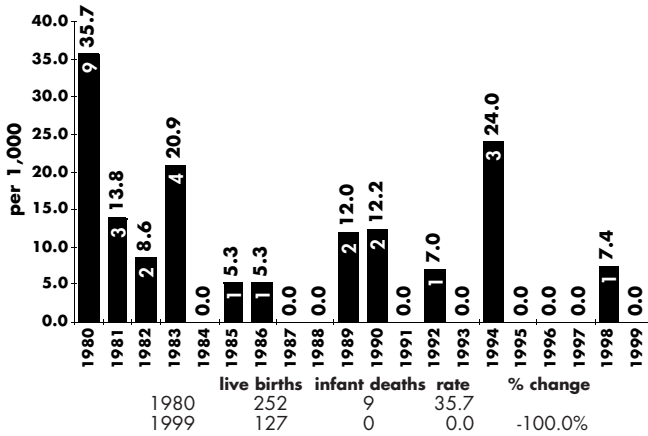


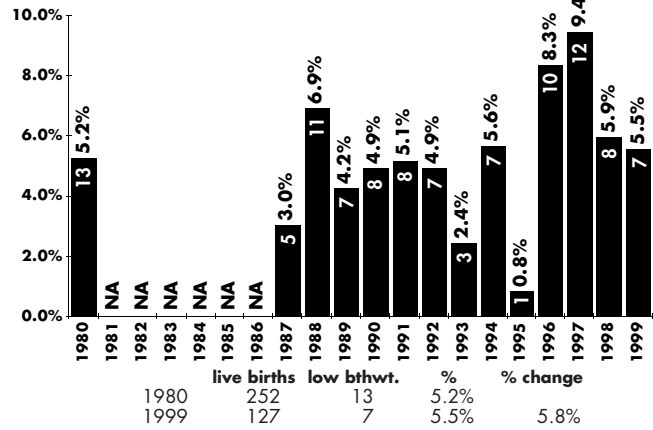

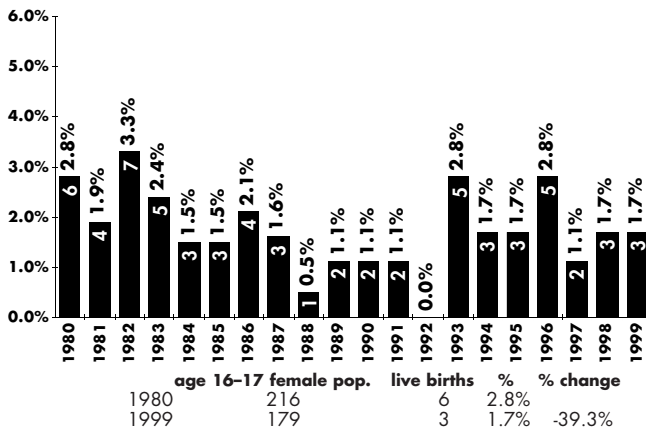
### Infant Mortality



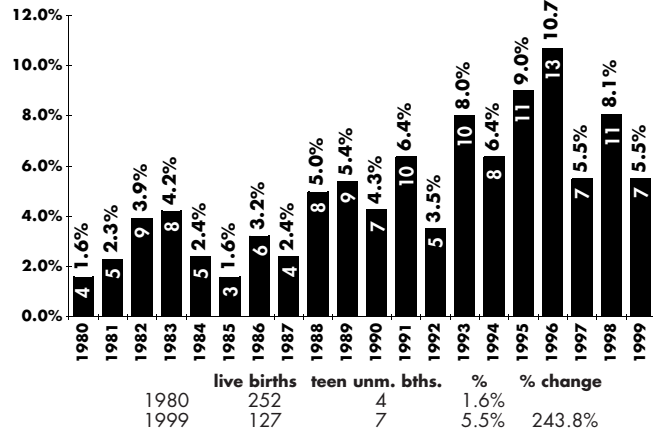
### Low Birthweight



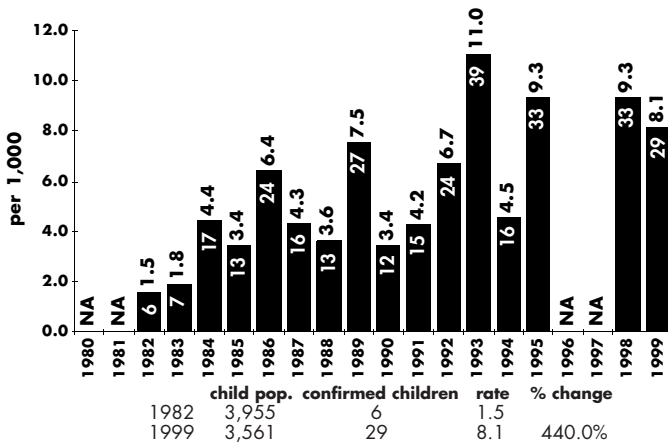
### Births to 16-17 Year Olds



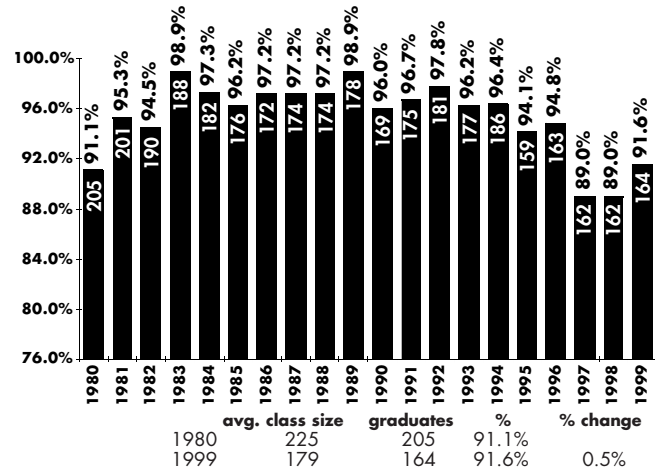
