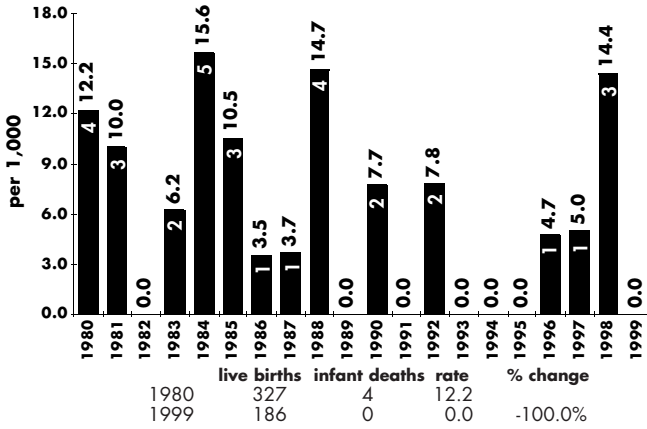


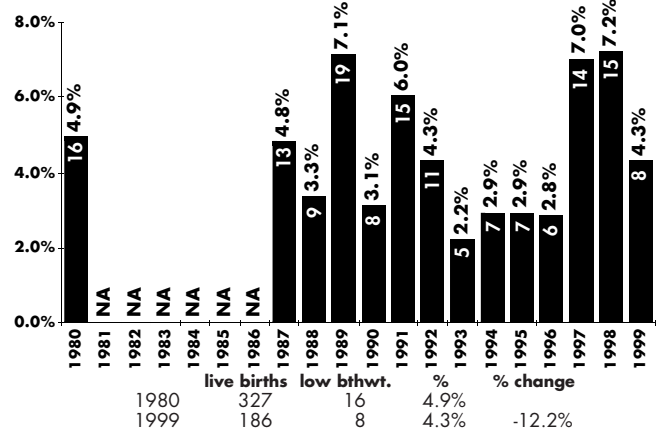

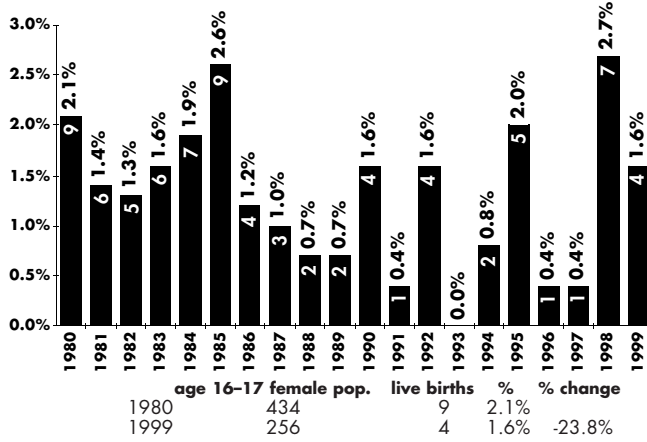
Infant Mortality



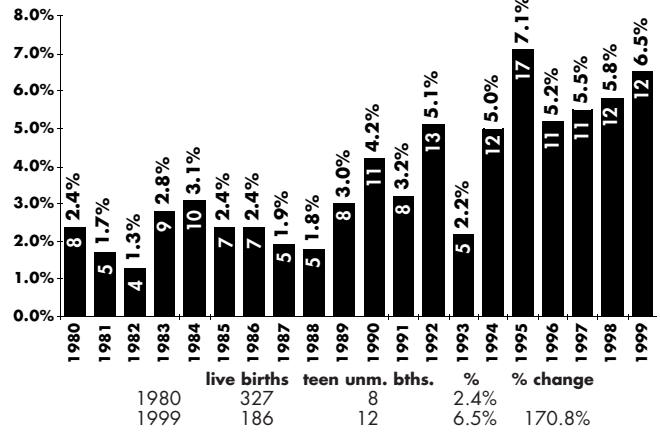
Low Birthweight



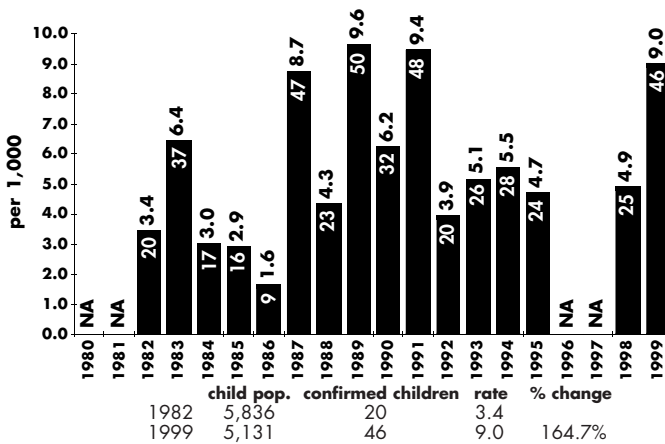
Births to 16-17 Year Olds



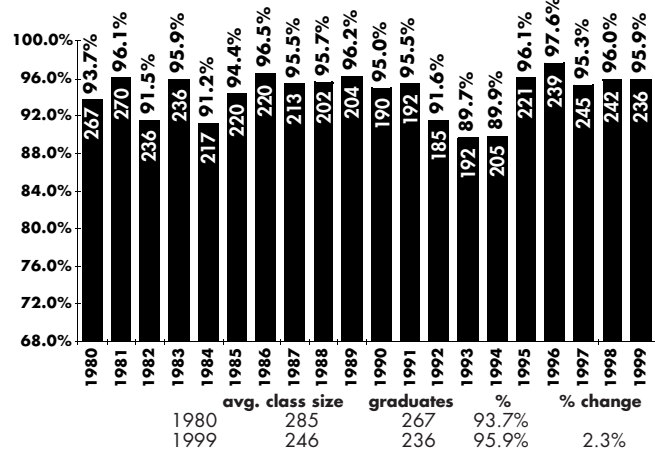
Teen Unmarried Births
